Who We Are

Habitat for Humanity of Greater Lowell is a non-profit 501 (c) 3 organization dedicated to eliminating substandard housing in the Greater Lowell area. An affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International, HFHGL has built or renovated 43 homes for families in need in our community, 42 Critical Home Repairs for veterans, seniors and the disabled as well as another 73 homes internationally through our tithing.

Habitat partner families are provided a hand up not a hand out to home ownership. Families must complete up to 450 of sweat equity hours, complete a financial course, a first time homebuyers course and a money matters class. Families also pay an interest free mortgage.

HFHGL is a grass roots/self funded organization and we could not build without support from donors and its dedicated network of volunteers. Help construct a house, participate in a HFHGL **Team Building Day**.
